- Gwinnett Alliance for Gifted Education is a non-profit volunteer group of parents, teachers, administrators, and community leaders committed to:
 - Enriching the learning environment of gifted and high achieving students.
 - Enhancing the professional learning of educators to meet the unique academic needs of gifted and high achieving students.
 - Educating the parents and community about the characteristics including the social and emotional needs of gifted and high achieving.
- Membership in GAGE includes automatic membership in the advocacy group at the state level, GAGC – Georgia Association for Gifted Children

Benefits that GAGE offers

- Provides free programs in Gwinnett for parents and educators concerning gifted students.
